Campers Code of Conduct

Parents are asked to read the instructions with the children and acknowledge to the camp staff during registration.

Following rules are formulated to ensure a friendly, peaceful and learning atmosphere for every one participating. It is required that everyone agrees with these Codes.

- 1. Abide by the camp schedule
- 2. Parents will be held responsible for damages caused by campers to the camp-site or any other private property during the camp
- 3. Proper clothing should be worn at the YFMC. Tank tops, halter-tops or short-shorts are prohibited
- 4. Firearms or any arms that could hurt someone is prohibited at the camp
- 5. Electronic device such as smart phones, tablets or game systems are prohibited during the camp
- 6. Venturing out of the camp area is strictly prohibited
- 7. Please use the trash bins located around the camp area and pay attention to recycle signs for proper disposal.
- 8. Please observe your behavior and follow SKDR principles (Safety, Kindness, Dedication to Truth and Respect for all)
- 9. The YFMC is a smoke free, drug free and alcohol free environment
- 10. During the activities bathroom usage will be managed to avoid rush. Use of bathroom breaks is encouraged
- 11. Finally, remember the SOS agreements of safety, kindness, dedication to truth and respect and have fun.
- 12. If you are sick especially if the sickness is contagious, please refrain from attending. This is to protect the health of others.
